The Pixel Project is looking for 1 – 2 people to join our editorial team that works on our annual “16 For 16” blog campaign as well as ad-hoc articles throughout the year.

You should be strongly supportive of women’s human rights and our mission to end violence against women.

All applicants must submit a portfolio of their published articles and writing samples.

The Editor’s duties include:

- Editing articles for our “16 For 16” campaign, our blog interview series, and ad-hoc articles
- Assisting with proof-reading articles
- Conducting research including sourcing news, studies, visuals, and other information needed for ensuring that articles are referenced accurately and
- Co-writing assigned articles for our “16 For 16” campaign with our in-house writers if need be.
- Assisting with sending invitations to interviewees if needed.

Skill Requirements:

The prospective in-house writer should have the following skills and experiences:

- Excellent editing and writing skills in English including experience with whipping less-than-ideal articles into shape.
- Experience in editing articles about topical issues (e.g. women’s human rights, healthcare, current affairs etc)
- Able to edit articles, copy etc according to house-style guidelines
- Excellent online research skills – able to track down relevant information, studies etc as part of ensuring that our articles are well-referenced.
- Reliable and excellent at meeting deadlines
- Communicates well with team members using tools such as e-mail, WhatsApp, and Signal for communication.
- Able to work with a virtual team across several time zones.

Volunteer Time:

This position requires an average of 2 - 7 hours per week and may vary as there are busy periods and quiet periods.

All editors are generally provided with reasonably long lead times for deadlines and are left to organise their own time. However, there may very occasionally be ad-hoc pieces which may require tight deadlines in line with breaking news about significant cases or events.
